To alleviate any food insecurities, Rockcastle County Schools Family Resource and Youth Service Center (FRYSC) Coordinators are working with identified families to meet such needs. **On a daily basis, FRYSC Coordinators and the District Food Service Director in partnership with Christian Appalachian Project (CAP) will address any food insecurities that arise for our families.** While exercising an abundance of caution, we will continue to model social distancing and other health precautions as recommended to protect our families, our staff and our community. For this reason, we will not have open feeding sites at this time.
