

You have completed a PCR (viral) COVID-19 test. This test technology detects active COVID-19 infections. **PCR testing only determines if you currently have active COVID-19 infection.** These results will **NOT** tell you if you had COVID-19 in the past and will **NOT** tell you if you will get COVID-19 in the future.

If you start experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, please get re-tested or consult your Primary Care Provider. The PCR test may not detect the virus until several days past the exposure. If you were exposed in the past few days, today's results could still be negative.

The information below explains PCR COVID-19 test results and what your next steps should be. Expect results in 72 hours. We will notify you as described below or you may access results via Labcorp's patient portal at patient.labcorp.com.

UNDERSTANDING YOUR PCR COVID-19 TEST RESULTS

DETECTED

Most likely you DO currently have active COVID-19 infection and can give the virus to others.

White House Clinics will CALL you with your results on the number you provided at registration.



- Follow up with your Primary Care Provider.
- Begin 14 day quarantine and isolate yourself from household members.

NOT DETECTED

Most likely you DO NOT currently have active COVID-19 infection.

Your negative results will be mailed to you.



- Continue social distancing, hand washing, and wearing a mask in public.
- If you develop symptoms, please contact your primary care provider as re-testing is recommended.

INDETERMINATE

Test results were inconclusive.

Re-testing is recommended to determine if you currently have COVID-19 infection.

White House Clinics will CALL you with your results on the number you provided at registration.



- Follow up with your Primary Care Provider.
- Self-isolate until re-testing is completed.
