

White House Clinics Commitment to Care Scholarship

White House Clinics is a non-profit community health center that provides medical, dental, behavioral health, and pharmaceutical services to one in five people living in our five-county service area. Dr. Philip Curd founded the organization in the early 1970s with a goal of making care accessible to people living in rural Kentucky regardless of whether they had insurance. Today that commitment to service remains and guides the work of our 350+ member team of health care professionals.

White House Clinics seeks to encourage high school graduates from the area to pursue careers in health care, to encourage them to return to our community after continuing their education, and to recognize the value of serving others in their future professions. White House Clinics will award a \$1,000 scholarship to one senior from each of the following high schools: Jackson County High School, Madison Southern High School, Berea Community High School, Madison Central High School, Model Laboratory School, Estill County High School, Rockcastle County High School, and Garrard County High School. Students receiving this award will be invited to take part in opportunities to shadow White House Clinics health professionals and/or other experiential learning activities throughout their undergraduate and graduate education.

Application Requirements

Scholarship applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 3.4 or higher; an ACT score of 24 or higher or SAT score of 1160 or higher; and plan to pursue a course of study leading to a career in medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, nursing, behavioral health, or social services.

- Copy of ACT/SAT Scores
- 2 letters of recommendation (including from at least one teacher)**

Scholarship recipients will be announced at the Senior Awards Ceremony of the respective high school and on our social media no later than 6/1/2024.
