

White House Clinics Community Health Champion Scholarship

White House Clinics is a non-profit community health center that provides medical, dental, behavioral health, and pharmaceutical services to one in five people living in our five-county service area. Dr. Philip Curd founded the organization in the early 1970s with a goal of making care accessible to <u>all</u> people in the rural communities we serve. Today that commitment to service remains and guides the work of our 350+ member team of health care professionals.

White House Clinics seeks to encourage graduates from our service area to pursue careers in health care, to encourage them to return to our community after continuing their education, and to recognize the value of serving others in their future professions. White House Clinics will award one \$2,500 scholarship to a student who graduated from high school in Jackson, Madison, Estill, Rockcastle or Garrard Counties, **AND** has been accepted into or is currently is enrolled in medical or dental school, **AND** has a desire to pursue a primary care, general dentistry, or public health practice. The scholarship will be extended to the winner in each subsequent year of enrollment in medical or dental school, provided that the award winner participates in at least two engagement and/or experiential learning activities with White House Clinics.

Application Requirements

Scholarship applicants must have graduated high school in Jackson, Madison, Estill, Rockcastle, or Garrard County, as well as completed their undergraduate studies from an accredited four-year college or university. Scholarship applicants must submit a letter of acceptance or proof of enrollment (transcript) indicating successful performance in medical or dental school, along with one letter of recommendation from a professor or other academic professional.

- Medical or Dental School Transcript <u>OR</u> Letter of Acceptance into an accredited Medical or Dental School.
- One letter of recommendation from a professor or other academic professional.
