



2025 Care for Kentucky Scholarship

White House Clinics is a non-profit community health center that provides medical, dental, behavioral health, and pharmaceutical services to one in five people living in our five-county service area. Dr. Philip Curd founded the organization in the early 1970s with a goal of making care accessible to all people. Today that commitment to service continues to guide the work of our 350+ member team of health care professionals.

White House Clinics supports Kentucky college students as they further their education in a healthcare-related field of study. The scholarship will be awarded to one qualified undergraduate student enrolled in a healthcare-related major or a major leading to a career in Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Nursing, or Behavioral Health. Applicants must have graduated from high school in Jackson, Madison, Estill, Rockcastle, or Garrard Counties, AND demonstrate a commitment to service during their pursuit of a higher education at a four-year, accredited college or university. The scholarship will be awarded to a rising Sophomore, Junior, or Senior in the amount of \$1,000.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Scholarship applicants must have graduated high school in Jackson, Madison, Estill, Rockcastle, or Garrard County, and be currently enrolled in a healthcare-related major or a major leading to a career in Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Nursing, or Behavioral Health. Applicants must also provide their college transcript, current GPA, documentation of their declared major, and two letters of recommendation (including one from a higher education faculty or staff member).

- College Transcript with current GPA
- Two letters of recommendation (one MUST be from a higher education faculty and/or staff member)
- Documentation from your college or university of your selected healthcare-related major or a major leading to a career in Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Nursing, or Behavioral Health.
